FAITH, My Friend, FAITH

For over two months, the name Covid-19 has hovered over America (and the world) like an ominous black cloud. It has become the primary thought upon everyone's mind, the centerpiece of nearly every conversation. After ninety-thousand deaths and nearly thirty-million jobs lost, I can understand why. With that said, I'll have to admit... I am growing tired of hearing and talking about Covid-19. I have a feeling you are too. I'm not trying to be presumptuous, pretending to know how you feel--most of us have never even met. It's just I'm seeing a change in the people around me and thought you may be experiencing something similar. Let me explain. I noticed I can cough at the store and no one looks at me like I have the black plague. I've noticed people are smiling at each other again, opening doors for each other, and not side-stepping each other at the grocery store like a Spanish matador side-stepping a blood-thirsty bull. It's refreshing to see. But what else should we expect? We are a strong, God-fearing people that have always bounced back from adversity. It's the American way! It's the Christian way! We face adversity and

God is for you, so who can be against you (Ro 8:31)? No one! That's who! You are more than a conqueror and can do all things through Christ who strengthens you (Ro 8:37, Php 4:13). Try to remember that your scars not only reveal where you were wounded, they point to where God healed you. If your wound is still gaping, be patient ... by His stripes we are healed (Isa 53:5).

The Galilean Children's Home was born in adversity. Jerry and Sandy Tucker have shed more tears and prayed more prayers than we could imagine, but their faith pushed them (and the Home) forward. Right now, as I write this newsletter, there are over twenty disabled children (physically/mentally challenged adults) living in our Blessing House, six older girls living with a dorm mother, several students from the Bahamas residing in our boarding house, two precious infants being cared for at the Angel House, over one-hundred students being educated at our Academy, and numerous other amazing contributions to our community and the world. I'm glad Jerry and Sandy kept fighting and forging their way through their dark times. And although I may

not know you, I'm glad you have kept forging your way through the darkness of Covid-19 (or whatever conflict you are facing)--your perseverance will be a blessing to someone else-- promise you!

to escape even there is no way (1Co 10:13). You have to believe that He is and that is a rewarder to those that diligently seek Him (Heb 11:6). You have to believe that if you call upon God in your distress, He will hear you and deliver you (Ps 34:4, 120:1).

I'm reminded of the story I heard about a farmer and his billy goat. The farmer loved and cherished his goat, treating him like one of his own children. One day 'al Billy fell into an old, dried-out well. The farmer tried every conceivable manner of rescuing him, but couldn't. Brokenhearted, he decided he'd bury 'al Billy in the well, giving him a proper burial. He went out to the shed and retrieved his wheelbarrow and shovel. Over and over again, he filled the wheelbarrow with dirt and poured it into the well. He couldn't muster up the courage to look into the well; his heart broke over the thought of his horned friend being buried alive. After a couple hours of digging and dumping dirt, he decided to look inside the well to see if Billy was indeed buried and out of his misery. The farmer was shocked at what he saw. Instead of Billy being buried alive, Billy was standing on top of the dirt! Instead of the dirt burying Billy, Billy was shaking the dirt off of his back and stomping it down. The more dirt the farmer poured on him the higher Billy arose, the closer he got to the mouth of the well. It wasn't long until 'al Billy, dirty and tired, hopped out of the well and returned home with the farmer.

So let it be in your life! When ol' slewfoot, or Covid-19, or sickness, or financial distress starts dumping dirt on your head, shake it off and stomp it down in Jesus' name! Like Lazarus of old, this sickness, this pain, this trial isn't unto death ... it's going to result in the glory of God shining through your situation (Joh 11:4). Like Joseph, in the Book of Genesis, what the devil meant for evil, God is going to turn it into something good (Ge 50:20).
